



1. Pedestrian Zones - Cycling permitted 24/7 hours

The sign on the left means **motor vehicles** are prohibited from entering the pedestrian zone except for those listed underneath the motor cycle and car symbol, (Diagram 618.3 in TSRDG). As cycles are classed as **vehicles** they are exempted from the prohibition. The table below lists towns and cities where cycling is allowed in pedestrian zones at all the times to encourage other local authorities to consider this option.

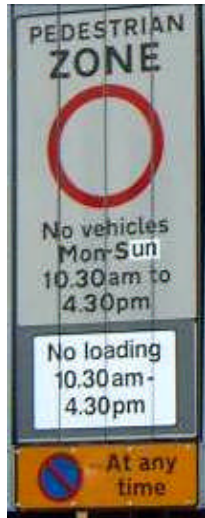

2. Pedestrian Zones - Cycling permitted during commuter hours

The sign on the left is a variable message sign (VMS) showing **all vehicles** including cycles are prohibited entering the pedestrian zone **except for those activities and times listed** underneath (Diagram 618.2 in the TSRDG). The sign on the right shows the VMS sign face when **motor vehicles** are banned but cycles exempted. The table below lists streets where cycling is allowed during commuter hours to encourage other areas to consider this option.
